Municipality of Bitola

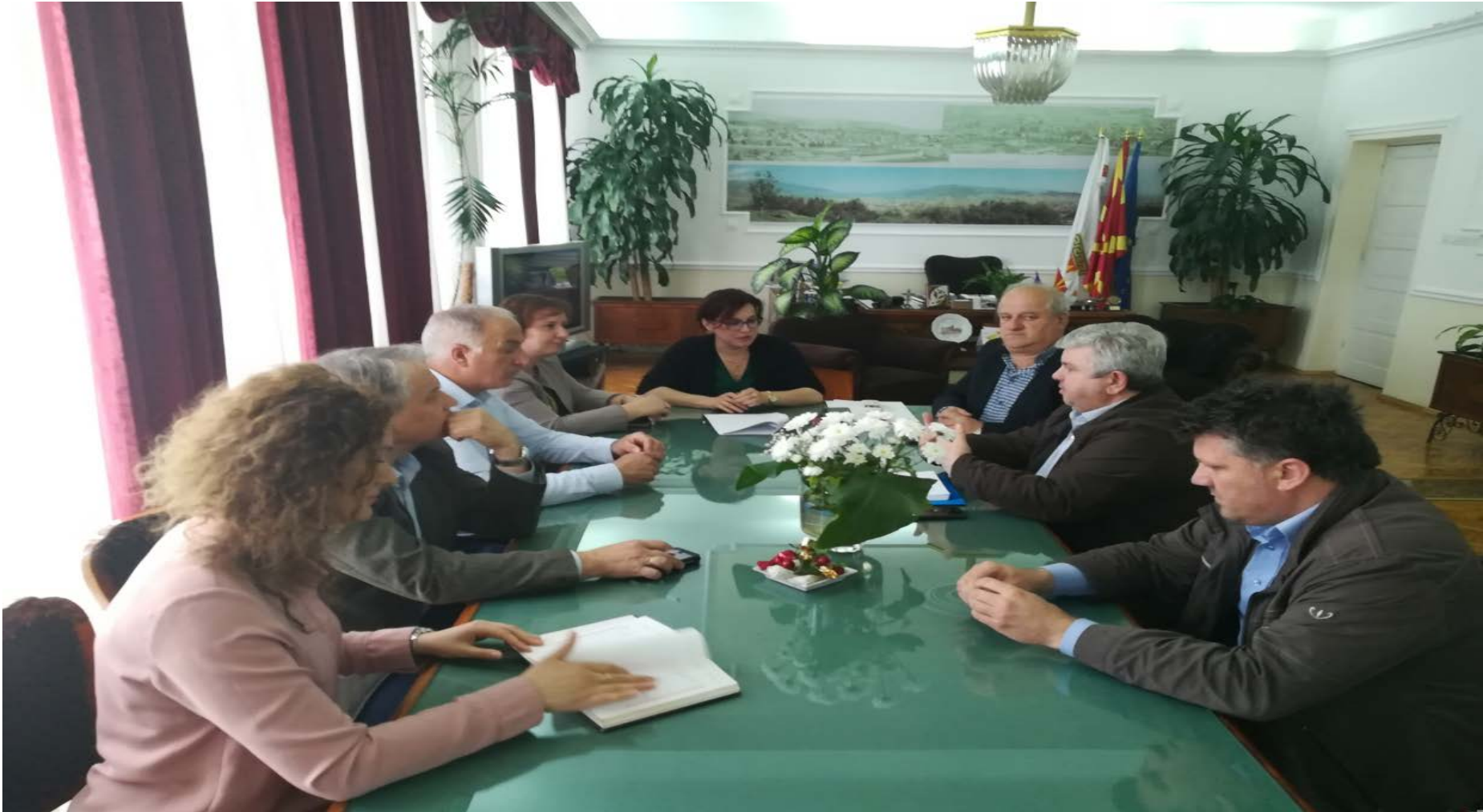
The municipality of Bitola is located in the south-western part of the country. In the west, the municipality borders the Municipality of Resen, where the border between the two municipalities passes through the Baba Mountain. The southern border is the state border with Greece. In the east and northeast, the Municipality of Bitola is bordered by the Municipality of Novaci and the Municipality of Mogila, while in the north with the Municipality of Demir Hisar. The municipality is located in the Pelagonia valley, reaching the highest peaks of Mount Baba with the peak Pelister. Pelister is also known for its two mountain lakes, which are called Pelister's Eyes and it is a National park. Black River and Dragor River flows through the municipality. In our Municipality there is an ancient city of Heraclea.

The municipality of Bitola has a surface area of 794,53 square km which covers the city of Bitola and the surrounding 65 villages with total number of inhabitants of 95385, of which 46969 are men and 48416 are women, according to the State Statistical Office, Census 2002.

Administratively, the city of Bitola is the seat of the Municipality of Bitola, but also the main regional center for the southwest region of the country and largest city centre in the Pelagonia valley. City of Bitola is 13 km from the Greek border.
